I. \_\_\_\_\_ THE HOLINESS OF GOD.

A. Isaiah had a life-changing vision of God's throne. **Is. 6:1-4; Rev. 4:8-11**

B. Life-change happens when we see God for who He really is. **Mt. 10:28; Eph. 3:20-21; Rom. 8:28**

II. \_\_\_\_\_ HOLINESS AS HE IS HOLY. **1 Pet. 1:13-16.**

A. Isaiah's response to the vision was fear and confession.

1. The fear of the Lord took on a whole new meaning. **Is. 6:5a**

2. Isaiah confessed his own sinfulness **Is. 6:5b-c**

3. Isaiah could not cleanse His own sin.

B. God calls you to be holy.

1. Receive God's cleansing from sin. **1 Jn 1:9; Titus 3:3-7; Acts 26:17-18.**

2. Conduct yourself in fear. **1 Pet. 1:17-19; Php. 2:9-12.**

III. \_\_\_\_\_ THE LORD IN HOLINESS. **Isaiah 6:8-13.**

A. Isaiah's message contained both judgment and hope.

1. Isaiah warned Judah of God's impending judgment.

2. Isaiah promised God's faithful a glorious future. **Is. 7:14; 53:1-3,5; 9:6-7; Isaiah 2:1-4; Is. 11:1-4.**

B. Serve the Lord in holiness. **2 Pet. 3:10-14.**
